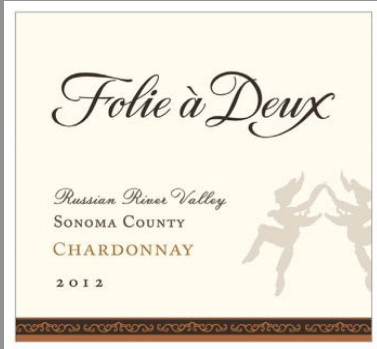

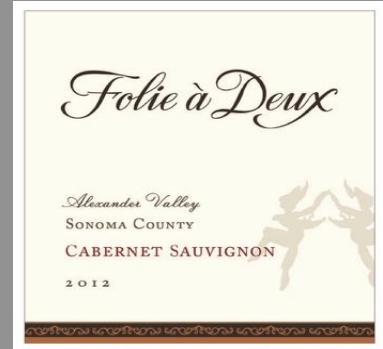
WINTER WHITE WINE FEATURE



The Folie à Deux 2012 Chardonnay is rich and seductive. Its complex aromas of warm shortbread, cinnamon, pear and melon overtones touch the nose, while flavors of fuji apple, tangerine,

and pineapple citrus rest on the palate. Lingering hints of vanilla are present in the finish. This wine is full-bodied with depths of fruit from the partial malolactic fermentation, creating creamy texture and vibrant acidity. For a great food pairing, serve this wine with poached salmon or pan seared scallops.

The 2012 Folie à Deux Alexander Cabernet Sauvignon embraces the essence of Alexander Valley and winemaker's harmonious style - an elegant and supple wine with

soft, plush tannins and well-balanced acidity. The nose boasts aromas of rich berries, black currant, dark plum, and violets followed by subtle hints of dried sage and black tea. Bright berry fruit and a touch of toffee carry through to the finish.
